Your award includes your **maximum** Federal Direct Loan eligibility. All borrowers must be enrolled at least halftime at the time of disbursement to be eligible to receive any loan funds.

Outside Scholarships and Private Loans: Scholarships and/or loans outside of those listed above can be applied to your account. Parent Loans for Undergraduate Students (PLUS): This is a loan taken out by a parent for student educational expenses. There is an application and an approval process. Payment Plan: The total out of pocket cost for the year can be paid through a five-month payment plan for each semester. The payment plan for the Fall semester is over the months of June, July, August, September, and October. The payment plan for the Spring semester is over the months of November, December, January, February, and March. Payments are due on the 31st of each month and can be set up with our Student Accounts/Business Office.
