Payment Plan: The total out of pocket cost for the year can be paid through a five-month payment plan for each semester. The payment plan for the Fall semester is over the months of June, July, August, September, and October. The payment plan for the Spring semester is over the months of November, December, January, February, and March. Payments are due on the31st of each month and can be set up with our Student Accounts/Business Office.
