This year, all students receive **FREE BREAKFAST**. Eligibility for meals is good through the remainder of the school year. The reduced price for lunch is \$0.40. If you wish to share your student(s) meal status to reduce school fees, take this letter to your student's school at the time of fee payment and complete the Consent for Disclosure form during online enrollment to designate which school fees to be considered for reduction.
