Included with this letter is a federal tax document called **IRS Form 1095-B: Health Coverage**. There is one 1095-B form for each person in your household who was enrolled in Health First Colorado (Colorado's Medicaid Program) or Child Health Plan *Plus* (CHP+) at any time in 2023.

Form 1095-B is your proof that you had health coverage during the month(s) you and others in your household were enrolled in Health First Colorado or CHP+. This form is for tax purposes only.

**Helpful Information**

**What do I need to do with my 1095-B form(s)?**

Keep IRS Form 1095-B with your other tax documents for your records. Do not return Form 1095-B to your county. If you file taxes, do not attach Form 1095-B with your tax return.

**Who do I contact if I think there is a mistake on my form?**

- Call the Health First Colorado Member Contact Center at 1-800-221-3943/State Relay: 711,
- For changes to name, address, or Social Security Number, go to your [Colorado.gov/PEAK](https://colorado.gov/PEAK) account. Click on "Manage My Account" and "Report My Changes," and enter the updated information.
