Annual Cost of Attendance for the 2023-2024 Financial Aid Year

Cost of Attendance (COA) is an estimated amount it will cost you to go to school full time. Citrus College calculates the COA to show the total cost **for the school year (for instance, for the fall semester plus the spring semester).**

If you're attending school at least half time, the COA is the estimate of tuition and fees, cost of housing and food (or living expenses), cost of books, course materials, supplies, and equipment, cost of transportation, loan fees, and miscellaneous expenses.

B-I CA College Promise Grant
